AGREED FINAL JUDGMENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE COMING TO BE HEARD on the agreement of all parties to this cause to enter an Agreed Final Judgment Order, the parties having reported to the Court that they have settled, compromised, adjusted, and adjourned all matters and issues between them pertaining to the above entitled cause; and the parties having further reported to the Court that they have agreed to and consent to be bound by the terms of the agreement hereinafter set forth; and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

NOW THEREFORE, UPON AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES HERETO, THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Respondent, William T. Bowen, is hereby found to be in minor indirect criminal contempt of court for engaging in the unauthorized practice of law by providing legal advice and services, including the preparation of a dissolution of marriage petition for William Clark ("Clark") in *Clark v. Clark*, Cook County case number 2017 D 1994.

2. Respondent William T. Bowen is hereby sentenced to ^{six months} ~~one year~~ of non-reporting probation and a fine of \$500.


3. As a term of probation, Respondent William T. Bowen is hereby prohibited from engaging in any acts of unauthorized practice of law in Illinois by holding himself out as an attorney, lawyer, or counselor at law in this State, or by undertaking the provision of legal advice or services on behalf of others in this State, without first obtaining authorization from the Illinois Supreme Court to practice law.

4. The permanent injunction entered against Respondent William T. Bowen on February 27, 2015, in case number 14 MC1235 remains in full force and effect.

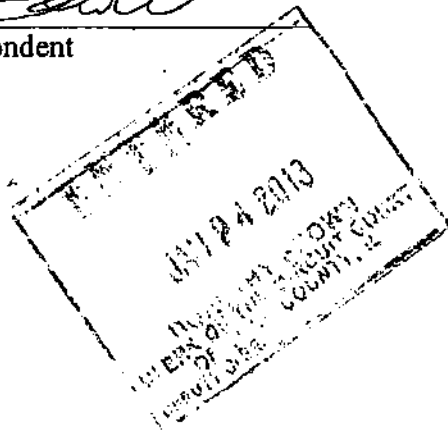
